

Volunteer Roles & Requirements



Programs Team

Work directly with kids and their families on a team with other volunteers and staff to create opportunities for hope and healing.

Build & Bloom Mentor: Work with a small group of boys (BUILD) or girls (BLOOM) to build healthy, trusting relationships that promote hope and healing. *Requirements: 18+, signed Statement of Faith, weekly or bi-monthly 2.5 hour commitment.*

Group Mentor: Work with kids of similar ages in skill-building group sessions. *Requirements: 18+, signed Statement of Faith, weekly or bi-monthly 2.5 hour commitment.*

Kids Give Back Mentor: Work with 1-3 kids to engage in serving the ranch together while helping them develop a sense of leadership and learn the value of giving back. *Requirements: 18+, signed Statement of Faith, bi-monthly or monthly 2.5-hour commitment.*

Listener: Support parents/guardians of session kids through listening, encouragement, and prayer. *Requirements: 30+, signed Statement of Faith, weekly or bi-monthly 2.5-hour commitment.*

Play Pal: Engage siblings of session kids in games, play and ranch fun. *Requirements: 16+, signed Statement of Faith, weekly or bi-monthly 2.5-hour commitment.*

Program Host: Welcome arriving families, provide hospitality, and support fellow program volunteers. *Requirements: 30+, signed Statement of Faith, weekly or bi-monthly 2.5-hour commitment.*

Additional Programs Team Requirements:

- Regular attendance at Saturday morning trainings once a month.
- Additional cost for purchase of uniform (shirt and name tag).

Ranch Team

Assist the Ranch Manager to maintain the safety, functionality and aesthetic integrity of Hope Reins as a safe haven for session kids and their families.

Ranch Hands: Upkeep of grounds, pastures and buildings, infrastructure development and hosting service groups. *Requirements: 18+ (13-17 w/ guardian), weekly participation encouraged, minimum 4-hour monthly commitment required.*

Barn Chores: Focus on grounds beautification, gardening and general property maintenance as a means for session kids to experience the Ranch as a safe haven. Great opportunity for families to serve together. *Requirements: 18+ (5+ w/ guardian), minimum 3-hour monthly commitment on Saturday 8-11am.*

Equine Team

Support the health & wellness needs of our horses as they prepare to connect with session kids.

Equine Support: These team members help provide hay, water and a well-kept environment for the herd during meal time. *Requirements: 18+, weekly 1.5 - 2 hours commitment.*
